- The judgement will be based on neatness, labelling, scale, title, accuracy, magnification, etc.

Specimen 1dentification

- · The Specimen must be identified by scientific name.
- 15 non chordate specimens will be provided.
- · Time provided for identification of each specimen will be 30 seconds.
- Spellings and format of writing will be evaluated during specimen identification.







Powerpoint Presentation

- A powerpoint presentation will be provided to the participant at the competition venue.
- The total number of slides in the presentation will be less than 10.
- · The topic of presentation will be related to Butterflies.
- · The participant has to present the given slide in front of the judges.
- Maximum time allotted for the presentation will be 5 minutes, followed by interaction with the judging panel.

Abstract writing

- A Scientific publication will be given to each participant at the beginning of the competition.
- After reading the article, the participant had to write an abstract of the given article in not less than 200 words.
- Maximum time allotted for the competition will be 30 minutes.
- Content, language, way of convincing the idea etc. will be considered for judgement.
