IQAC Action Taken Report 2022-2023

Subsequent to the meetings of IQAC held for the year 2022-23, the following actions were taken for the smooth functioning of the institution and for the completion of IQAC procedures on time.

June 2022

1. World Environmental Day Celebration (5th June 2022)

- The students conducted awareness classes in nearby schools, emphasizing the importance of environmental conservation. This initiative inspired young minds to take action in protecting the environment.

2. Books on Wheels (24th June 2022)

- An initiative by NSS in association with The Cochin College Library to distribute books among senior citizens, aimed at promoting reading habits. The project fostered a sense of community and connection among the elderly.
